Camper Rules & Regulations

ALL CAMPERS

1. May **not** leave campgrounds without written permission from Registration Staff.
2. Must not leave cabins from midnight until 6 AM without permission from Counselor.
3. Must not be in cabin area from 9:00 AM until NOON without permission from Counselor.
4. Must attend all activities in the Sanctuary and/or Rec Hall.
5. No mixed swimming.
6. No pairing off of boys with girls. No holding hands, no kissing, no necking.
7. No boys allowed in girls cabins or restrooms
8. No girls allowed in boys cabins or restrooms.
9. No hitting, no kicking, no fighting.
10. No profanity, no smoking, no drugs, no alcoholic beverages, no chewing tobacco, no matches, no cigarettes or cigarette lighters, or any other instrument of flame. No knives, no guns, no chains or any other instrument used harmfully.
11. No damage to or altering of camp property or facilities, supplies or products. All costs of repairs shall be at your expense and you will be sent home.
12. No rock music, rap, country western, Christian rock or alternative music on the campgrounds.
13. No cell phones calls OR text messaging without Counselor, Registration, Parent or Pastor permission.
14. No video games **of any kind**.
15. **NO WRESTLING.**
16. Must respectfully obey all requests and orders of staff and camp owners at all times.
17. No stealing or damaging personal belongings of campers or cabins.
18. Must wear your name tag everyday.
19. No sale of unauthorized food, drink or products allowed.
20. Swimmers must wear a covering in the pool area.
21. Water Fights: allowed at specified times only. Cannot involve any persons not participating. Plastic covering for water fighters –trash bags available at Registration.
22. No pets allowed whatsoever.

(Jr Campers follow pastor's church standards for sleeve length.) 5. No tight or sheer clothing. 6. No low neck lines. 7. No belly-button shirts. No mid-riff shirts – when you raise your arms, no exposed flesh. 8. No low hip skirts; no stomachs showing at anytime. 9. No jewelry, no rings of any kind. No wedding rings or bands. 10. No makeup of any kind or nail polish. 11. Hosiery must be worn to Evening Services, ages 13 up, under age 13 dress socks or hosiery. 12. Dress attire at Evening Services. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. No shorts. 2. No jewelry. No rings of any kind. No wedding rings or bands. 3. No tight or sheer clothing. 4. Clean-shaven. 5. Good haircut – off the ears/off collar. 6. Sleeves must be below the elbow. (Under age 10 may follow pastor's church standards for sleeve length.) 7. No belly-button shirts. 8. No baggy or low-hanging pants. 9. Dress attire at Evening Services.

CAMPER OF THE YEAR AWARDS

Each day a Junior Boy/Girl and a Senior Boy/Girl will be selected as “Camper of the Day”. The following is the criteria that the staff will use in the selection process. There will be a gift reward for each Camper of the Day selected. On the last day of camp, the staff will select one Junior Boy/Girl and one Senior Boy/Girl to be **CAMPER OF THE YEAR**. These 4 persons will receive paid registration to Camp Niangua 2012.

1. Must be on-time to Pep Rally, Classes and Evening Services.
2. Must participate in planned activities.
3. Must show enthusiasm and cooperation in all planned activities.
4. Must show the following attributes: friendliness, helpfulness, kindness, truthfulness, cleanliness.
5. Must abide by all Camp Rules and Regulations.
6. Must not have an “Incident Report” on file with Registration.
7. Must wear a name badge every day.
8. Must maintain excellent attitude toward all staff and fellow campers.
9. Must keep bedding, bath and personal belongings neat and orderly.
10. Must be a good sport.
11. Must pray during Prayer Services, must worship during worship services and must be attentive to preaching and teaching.
12. Must maintain clean hygiene.
13. May not have been a previous Camper of the Year recipient.

Cabin of the Day & Cabin of the Year

Each morning the cabins will be toured by the staff and judged. At each evening service, the Cabin Banner will be presented to one Junior Boy/Junior Girl Cabin, one Senior Boy/Senior Girl Cabin. These banners are to be displayed on the front door of the cabin for the day. All Cabin of the Year Recipients will receive a free 2011 Photo CD. The following is the criteria that the judges will use when touring the cabins:

- #1. Cleanliness and neatness.
- #2. Improvements from past inspections.

NOTICE RE: CABIN INSPECTIONS

Judges **will not** base their decisions on bribes. Cabin decorations/enhancements that are brought to the cabin **after** Registration Day will not be judged. You may use only the items that you **bring with you** on Registration Day. Violators will be disqualified.
