Dear Pastor:

Camp Niangua is an operating church campground owned by the Free Will Baptist of Missouri. It is approximately 30 miles east of Springfield, Missouri, on I-44, exit 100, Marshfield. It has the following services and amenities: worship center, commercial kitchen, dining hall, snack bar, laundry room, private Olympic swimming pool plus a smaller 4-foot pool, basketball, baseball, volleyball, ping-pong, and miniature golf. All cabins/dorm rooms are air-conditioned. (No pets allowed whatsoever.)

Eligible Campers: ages are 7-12 (Juniors) and ages 13-Unmarried (Seniors). Juniors and Seniors will be divided in the following areas: classes, games, specified organized activities and special events. Campers will be assigned to cabins/dorm rooms by their ages.

The goal And Purpose of Camp Niangua: To have a positive atmosphere where youth are encouraged to have clean Godly fun with firm guidelines and well-managed organization. Disciplinary action will be taken if and when necessary, however the emphasis will be placed on a positive and enthusiastic atmosphere generated by the attitudes of the staff who care and love young people. Our objective is to have an unforgettable week of fun and Holy Ghost power where our youth are filled to the overflowing in an **old-fashioned Apostolic downpour**.

Required Volunteers: 1 adult volunteer is required from each church for up to every 4 campers sent. In other words, **if you are sending 4 or less campers, you will need to send at least 1 volunteer**. If you send 5-8 campers, we will need at least 2 volunteers, 9-12 you need to send 3 volunteers, and so on. Volunteers are vital to the success of the camp and must be 21 years or older with Pastor's signed recommendation on their application form. There is no way this camp can operate for our youth without our collective assistance.

Rules and Regulations: We do reserve the right to enforce all of the 2011 Rules and Regulations. Please make sure your campers have read and understand them.

Registration and Refund Policy: Camp Niangua is a labor of love and not a money making venture for Diggins Apostolic Church. All churches, volunteers, and camp staff pay the registration fee. Supplies, shirts, food, etc. are ordered for camp by the first week of June using the number of registrations we have, plus an additional percentage to cover walk-in registrations. Therefore, we must strictly follow our refund policy. The refund schedule is as follows: a full refund will be issued if requested by June 3, 2011. A 50% refund will be issued from June 4-17. There **will be no refunds** on or after **June 18**. However, you are able to substitute or replace campers or volunteers with no penalties before camp starts on the 25 of June.

This camp can comfortably hold about 400 persons, including staff, volunteers and campers. Registration will be granted on a first-come/first-serve basis. **The early registration deadline is May 15, 2011**. Registration must include a completed and signed application as well as the full registration amount. I urge all prospective campers and volunteers to act as quickly as possible to insure a place has been reserved for you.

Church Information Form: Please make sure that you complete and mail the "Church Information Form" back with your church's registration forms.

Camp T-Shirts: Camp T-shirts (long sleeve) are provided as part of the **camper's registration fee only**. Volunteers, pre-campers, little-campers, ministers and their wives may purchase a camp shirt on their respective forms. Please note we can only guarantee that campers who pre-register will receive a shirt.

A complete set of all forms are enclosed: Photocopy forms as necessary. Please photocopy them in the configuration in which they are mailed to you for easy processing.
